



Do you have a child 6 years old or younger living in your home?

Was your home built before 1978?

Are there visible signs of flaking paint or dust by the doors or windows?

If you answered yes to the above questions, you may be eligible to participate in the **GET THE LEAD OUT Program**. The City of Urbana, the Champaign-Urbana Public Health District and the Illinois Department of Public Health are working together to promote lead safe housing.

Grant funds are available to eliminate lead hazards in and around your home. This may include replacing doors and windows, covering exposed outside trim with aluminum, etc. Grants have averaged \$8,500 per household.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ You must be a homeowner.
- ✓ Your home must be within Urbana city limits.
- ✓ Your total household income may not exceed 50% of the area's Median Family Income (see below).
