

HELPFUL HINTS

Always carry change for parking meters when driving to campus and downtown. Urbana meters accept coins (nickel, dime, quarter) and CashKeys. The meters will not accept dollar coins. Check street signs and look at information stickers on each meter for specific parking instructions.

Purchase a CashKey by visiting one of the three parking entities in the campus district. The CashKey is a programmable key that provides a cashless way to pay parking meters. Call (217) 384-2346 for more information.

Use the Mass Transit District to avoid campus area parking hassles. Students have unlimited MTD bus service simply by using their University identification card. For more information about MTD call (217) 384-8188.

Students and visitors to the campus area can also take advantage of the University's remote parking lots and shuttle service. For information regarding these services contact University of Illinois Facilities Services, Parking Division at (217) 333-3530 or at www.parking.illinois.edu.

PARKING LOCATIONS, HOURS & RATES

Campus area meters are color-coded by length of time available on the meter. Red is 30 minutes or less, blue is 2 hours and gray is 10 hours. Meters in the campus area have a rate of \$1.00 per hour.

Downtown area meters have various time lengths and are black in color regardless of length of time available on the meter. They have a rate of \$.25 per hour.

Hospital area meters around Carle Clinic and Carle Hospital are gray in color and have a rate of \$1.00 per hour.

Municipal Parking Garage parking is located at 100 W. Main Street in Downtown Urbana. Parking is available for \$.25 for the first hour and \$.50 for each additional hour.

Champaign County PayStation Lot parking is located at 200 E. Main Street, which is on the east side of the courthouse. Parking is available for \$.25 for the first hour and \$.50 for each additional hour.

Hours of enforcement and metered rates are listed inside each meter. Campus and hospital meters are enforced Mon. - Sat., 7 AM to 6 PM. The Downtown Urbana area is enforced Mon. - Fri., 8 AM to 5 PM.

OFFICIAL CITY HOLIDAYS

Parking meters are not enforced on the following official City holidays:

HOW TO AVOID PARKING TICKETS



The City of Urbana, the City of Champaign and the University of Illinois, depending upon specific locations, enforce campus area parking. Each entity has their own enforcement regulations and the information contained herein may not apply to parking tickets received from either the University of Illinois or the City of Champaign. All meters are labeled with the parking authorities logo.



PARKING REGULATIONS

Prohibited Parking is not allowed at any time for any reason. The city does not place a sign directly in front of each space where parking is prohibited. The signs are clearly posted in parking lots and at regular intervals on city streets. Some areas are unmarked, such as, within 5 feet of any driveway, within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, within 30 feet of any intersection or crosswalk and within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad grade crossing.

Restricted Parking is not allowed during certain conditions or time periods. Parking restrictions for certain streets and parking lots is indicated by street signs. These restrictions inhibit on-street vehicle storage and allow for street cleaning, maintenance and snow removal. Vehicles parked in these areas during restricted hours are subject to tickets and towing.

Other restrictions may apply, so always check the street for signs posted on the block where you plan to park before parking your vehicle. You can also visit us at www.urbanaininois.us/parking to learn more about our Urbana Local Traffic Code.

PERMITS & WAIVERS

Resident permits for the West Urbana Special Parking Zone are required for all on-street parking between the hours of 3 AM to 3 PM, M-F. The zone is bounded by Green Street, Race Street, Florida Avenue and Lincoln Avenue and you must live within those boundaries to be eligible for permits. Residents may apply for the following types of permits:

- **Annual Day/Night** - Valid M-F, 3 AM - 3 PM
Cost is \$135.00.
- **Annual Daytime** - Valid M-F, 7 AM - 3 PM
Cost is free.
- **Temporary Day/Night** - Valid M-F, 3 AM - 3 PM
Cost is \$2.00 a day or \$5.00 for 3 days.
- **Temporary Daytime** - Valid M-F, 7 AM - 3 PM
Book of 20 permits. Cost is free.
- **Landlord Service Vehicle** - Valid M-F, 3 M - 3PM. 1-10 permits. Cost is free. (Not for resident use.)
- **Service Vehicle** - Valid M-F, 3 AM - 3 PM
Cost is \$20.00 per permit.
- **Resident Construction & Medical** - Valid M-F, 3 AM - 3 PM. Up to 30 days at a time for resident construction permits and 180 days for resident medical permits. Cost is free.

Permits are not valid in any other location and do not exempt the vehicle from complying with the 72 hour parking ordinance.

Waivers for special events are available to residents and landlords by contacting the Finance Department within 48 hours of the event. For more information on how to apply for permits and waivers, please call (217) 384-2346.

PARKING RENTAL PROGRAM

Rented parking spaces are available in the downtown area. If you are interested in renting a space in one of our lots, please call the Municipal Collector's Office for availability and rates.

HOW TO FILE A DISPUTE

If a meter malfunctions, or if you question the validity of a parking ticket for some other reason, you may contest the ticket within 72 hours of receipt in any of the following ways:

By mail or fine box: Write a short note stating the problem (include your name and address), insert the note and the ticket in the ticket envelope, and either mail (requires postage) or drop it in a City of Urbana yellow fine box.
