## **ARMD ROBBERY ARRESTS – URBANA**

On Friday, October 28, 2022, at about 10:57 PM the victim of an Armed Robbery flagged down Urbana Police Officers. Police learned that the victim was lured to a secondary location in the Aspen Court Apartment Complex after agreeing to buy items via social media. The victim was robbed at gunpoint with an extended magazine pistol by 3 males and during the robbery, he was struck in the head with the pistol. The victim received medical treatment for injuries sustained during the incident.

On Saturday, October 29, 2022, at about 4:31 PM, Urbana Officers were directed to two males suspected of the above-mentioned robbery in the Aspen Court Apartment Complex. Both males refused officers' commands to stop and fled the scene. One male, 21-year-old, Jakeif Green of Urbana, was arrested prior to entering an address in the 1500 block of Hunter Street. The other male who fled from the police was also later found inside the same address. He was identified as a 16-year-old male from Urbana who also had an outstanding warrant of apprehension for Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer. A court-order search of the residence was conducted and police found evidence stolen from the victim as well as an extended magazine pistol inside.

The juvenile arrestee was ultimately transported to the Champaign County Youth Detention Center and is awaiting further legal proceedings for Armed Robbery. Green was transported to the Champaign County Satellite Jail and was issued a bond in the amount of \$150,000 for Armed Robbery. The third offender is still at large and the investigation into this matter is ongoing.

Caller ID tracking is not utilized by Crime Stoppers and conversations are not recorded.

Crime Stoppers will pay cash rewards of \$5,000 for tips that lead to an arrest in any homicide case, \$2,500 for tips leading to an arrest in a felony crime involving a firearm, and up to \$1,000 for tips leading to the arrest of the person(s) responsible for any other crime.
