SHOOTING WITH INJURIES

On Sunday, June 1st, 2024 around 7:46 pm, Urbana patrol officers were dispatched to the intersection of Hunter and Lierman in southeast Urbana for a report of a shooting with injuries. Officers located two victims, a 14-year-old and 16-year-old, both of whom were shot by an unknown subject.

Prior to the shooting a physical altercation took place at this intersection. A large number of people were present to observe this altercation. Shortly after the parties broke up, an unknown vehicle entered the area and an unknown subject exited the vehicle and began firing in the general direction of the crowd. The vehicle fled from the scene and was not located. The victims suffered one gunshot each, one in the abdominal region, while the other in the arm. Both victims were transported to Carle Emergency Department along with their parents who were summoned to the scene. The victims are in stable condition and their wounds are non-life threatening. It is believed at this time that the two gunshot victims were not involved in the initial altercation. This investigation is ongoing.

Community members are reminded that information submitted to Crime Stoppers is completely anonymous. Calls are routed to a third-party national call center that receives your information, completes a tip information form, and then passes the information to the appropriate law enforcement agency. Caller ID tracking is not utilized by Crime Stoppers, and conversations are not recorded.

Crime Stoppers will pay cash rewards of \$5,000 for tips that lead to an arrest in any homicide case, \$2,500 for tips leading to an arrest in a felony crime involving a firearm, and up to \$1,000 for tips leading to the arrest of the person(s) responsible for any other crime.
