URBANA HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE RELATED ROAD CLOSURES

The City of Urbana Public Works Department has approved a Special Event Permit Application from the Urbana High School for the Homecoming Parade. On Friday, September 27, 2024, portions of streets in the City of Urbana will be briefly closed to accommodate the event. The parade is scheduled to start at 3:30 p.m. and end at approximately 4 p.m.

The route for the parade is as follows:

- North on Race Street from Iowa Street to Washington Street
- East on Washington to Race Street
- North on Race to Main Street
- East on Main to Vine Street
- South on Vine to Washington Street
- West on Washington to Broadway Avenue (into the High School parking lot)

Traffic along the parade route will only be obstructed for the short time it takes for the parade to clear the area. Roads and intersections will be reopened as the last parade participants go through an area. Please expect delays in these areas. We appreciate your patience while this event is underway.
